

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GRAHAMDALE

BY-LAW NO. 999- 2017

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Grahamdale to establish a ward system for the purpose of electing municipal councillors.

WHEREAS sub-section 87(1) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

"Every member of a council is to be elected by a vote of the voters of the whole municipality unless the council by by-law provides that the councillors are to be elected on the basis of wards";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable to establish a ward system to elect councillors in the Rural Municipality of Grahamdale;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the council of the Rural Municipality of Grahamdale enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT the Rural Municipality of Grahamdale be divided into six (6) wards, as per attached Schedule A;
- 2) That each ward be represented by one (1) member of council elected within each ward;
- 3) That the six (6) Wards be named as follows: Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3, Ward 4, Ward 5 and Ward 6 as outlined on attached schedule "A".
- 4) THAT Ward By-law No. 884/97 be rescinded;
- 5) THAT this by-law takes effect at the next general municipal election.

DONE AND PASSED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Grahamdale in the Town of Moosehorn, in the Province of Manitoba this 14th day of September 2017.
