## 8.4 Noxious Weeds - Spotted Knapweed

WHEREAS the Interlake Weed District has notified the Municipality of knapweed present on Highway 325 east of Ashern, MB, between Roads 29W and 35W.

AND WHEREAS spotted knapweed is Tier 1 noxious weed in Manitoba, the most serious level, and the Noxious Weed Act specifies it must be controlled with eradication as the goal.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council authorize Fred Paulson, Weed Supervisor with the Interlake Weed District, to act on behalf of the R.M. of Grahamdale to enforce the Noxious Weeds Act so that an Official Notice to Control Weeds can be issued to Manitoba Transportation and Infrastructure for the spotted knapweed present on Highway 325.

WHEREAS Peter Hofbauer operates Steep Rock Kayak and Canoe, a business offering kayak, canoe, paddle board, and motorized boat rentals in Steep Rock.

AND WHEREAS Mr. Hofbauer continues to run his business on municipally owned land, specifically the Steep Rock Quarry located at 34-28-10WPM and SW 3-29-10WPM.

AND WHEREAS By-law 1075-2023 mandates that any commercial use of municipal land must be authorized by the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS Mr. Hofbauer is in violation of By-law 1075-2023 as he operates his business on municipal land without obtaining the necessary permission.

AND WHEREAS despite repeated requests from the Municipality to comply with By-law 1075-2023, Mr. Hofbauer has not applied for the required permission and continues his operations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Peter Hofbauer, Steep Rock Kayak and Canoe, and any other businesses owned or operated by Mr. Hofbauer, are prohibited from using, occupying, or accessing the municipally owned Steep Rock Quarry at 34-28-10WPM and SW 3-29-10WPM, effective immediately.
