Robert Filion present, representing the Applicant.

Reeve Howse called the Hearing to Order and outlined the process and procedures to anyone wishing to present.

CAO Schwitek read the Notice of Public Hearing pursuant to The Planning Act.

Proof of proper notice for the Notice of Public Hearing was stated.

Two people were in attendance, in person, to observe the proceedings.

No one in attendance via Zoom.

No written submissions were made.

Mr. Filion had nothing to add to the application.

Resident Tony Victor spoke against the application.

- T. Victor believes that a condition of any new subdivision should be a requirement to build, similar to what was required in the adjacent cottage subdivisions, developed by the Municipality.
- T. Victor believes this is desirable to create a consistent pattern of development in the area, and to maximize the Municipality's tax base.
- T. Victor asked if the recommended requirement was for an engineered drainage plan or a Technical Drainage Plan? - Administrative Assistant Shannon clarified that the recommended requirement by Manitoba Environment and Climate Change was for a Technical Drainage Plan, the proposed subdivision being less t than 9 lots.

Reeve Howse asked if there were any other persons wishing to speak. There were none.

Reeve Howse thanked everyone in attendance and declared the Public Hearing closed at 10:26 a.m.
